SMALL BEAR



- 1. Cut 2
- Trace/mark eyes and nose to front then apply face by:

(choose your method)

- A. paint on with acrylic paint, let dry (test on scrap fabric first)
- B. use permanent marker (Micron or Sharpie)
- C. embroidery floss (3 strands of black)
- D. applique

Tip - When using method A or B place paper under bear head to absorb excess paint/ink. Allow to dry thoroughly then iron to heat set.

- Place right sides together. Sew around bear using 1/4 seam allowance, leave a 2 inch opening near the leg/hip area.
- 4. Trim seam to 1/8
- 5. Turn bear inside out
- 6. Optional <u>lightly</u> stuff ears then sew along dotted line indicated on the pattern.
- 7. Fill with poly-fill/fiberfill.
- 8. Sew opening closed using a ladder stitch.
- 9. Cut a 15" ribbon (3/8" or 1/2") and tie around bears neck. Finished!
